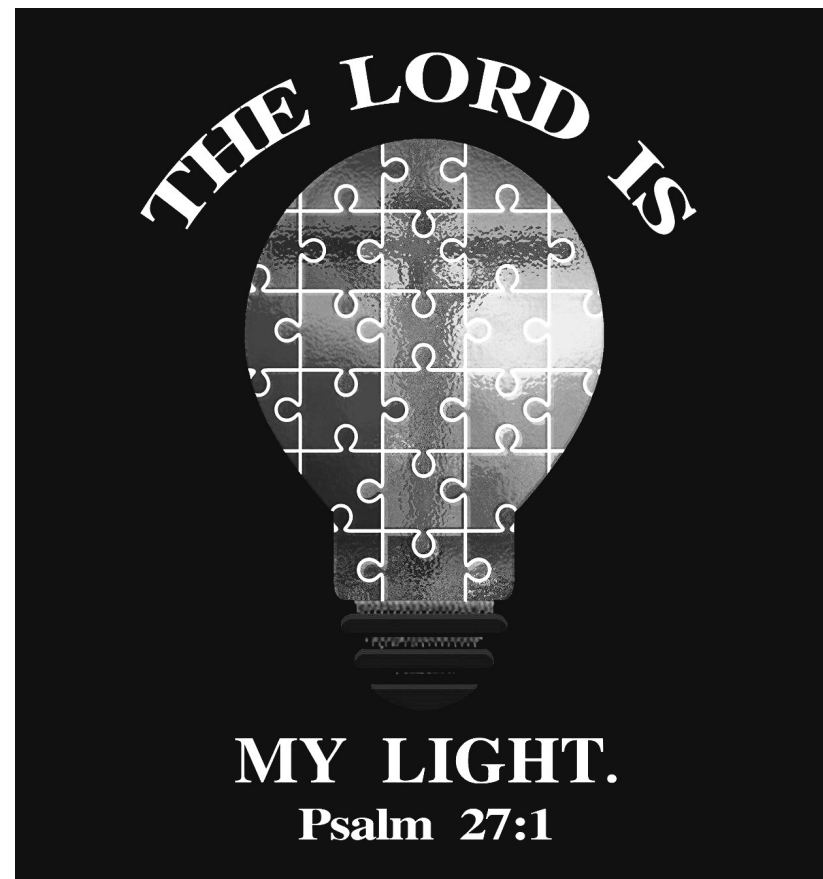

Celebrated since the end of the 2nd century, **Epiphany** is also known as Three Kings' Day or the Feast of the Epiphany. Having been celebrated before the Christmas holiday was even established, it is considered one of the oldest Christian celebrations

Epiphany means “manifestation” or “showing forth”. Celebrated twelve days after Christmas, Epiphany represents and celebrates the coming of the Three Wise Men or Magi who visited Bethlehem and presented gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh to the newborn baby...Jesus. This visit “revealed” Jesus to the world as Lord and King.
