NCG Payday Lending Hearing, Wednesday, March 20 at 12:30 p.m. Grant Sawyer Building. 555 East Washington Avenue. SB201 will enact an upfront software system that will hold lenders accountable to obeying the laws already in place to protect consumers. It also places a cap of 36% on consumer credit extended to a covered military service member or dependent. It is extremely important that there is a strong consumer presence at the hearing to demonstrate commitment for this bill. Please join us at the hearing.
